- 1. **Rules:** The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* 2005-2008.
- 2. Race Area: The race area will be in Galveston and Trinity Bays.
- 3. Classes: One-Design, PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non Spinnaker, ORC Club Spinnaker, ORC Club Non-Spinnaker, Short-handed Offshore Sailors (SOS), Women Crewed, and Multihull.
- 4. Class Size: A minimum of five boats constitutes a class.
- 5. Schedule:

- 6. Handicapping: All classes excepting One Design shall submit a current 2008 rating certificate from the cognizant rating authority (e.g. PHRF-GB, ORC Club, etc.) prior to the entry deadline. Multihull ratings must be obtained through Texas Offshore Multihull Association (TOMA). These requirements are an unconditional prerequisite for entry. No "club handicaps" will be assigned by the Race Committee. The Race Committee may, in its discretion, accept a late filed rating certificate.
- 7. **Conditions of Entry:** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (Bay Access Inc., Lakewood Yacht Club, the Race Committee, protest committee, sponsors, or any other

organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

- 8. **Waivers:** No boat shall participate in any race of this series unless the skipper and all crew members have signed the appropriate waiver of liability provided with this NOR, and the waivers are turned in to the Race Committee before the Skippers' Meeting. Failure to provide a signed waiver for each crew member will result in the entry being incomplete and the boat will not be considered to be participating in the event. At the discretion of the Race Committee Chair, signed crew member waivers may be accepted after the Skippers Meeting so long as they are received prior to the first race sailed by the signing crew member. Waivers may be faxed to LYC office 281.474.3502 or scanned and uploaded to: www.lakewoodyachtclub.com.
- 9. **Insurance:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.
- 10. **Entry Fees:** The Entry Fee is \$50. A \$5 discount is available for USSAILING Members. The Entry Fee is payable by credit card, yacht club reciprocal charge, or check. Entry fees will be refunded if a registrant notifies the Race Committee of the withdrawal on or before February 20, 2008.
- 11. **Entry Deadline:** The Entry must be submitted by 1700 on Wednesday, February 27, 2008. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee Chair but will require a \$75 tax-deductible donation to Bay Access, Inc.
- 12. **Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper's Meeting.
- 13. **Courses:** The Series is intended to offer an alternative to short course windward/leeward racing and to provide distance racing in sheltered waters. Courses will be designed to offer a mix of reaching, running and windward legs around both fixed and set marks. The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions. It is contemplated that a single race will be conducted with distance on the order of 5 to 20 nm depending on wind conditions.
- 14. **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Race Notice Board at Lakewood Yacht Club.
- 15. **Scoring and Prizes:** Awards shall be presented to no more than 3 places in each class. In order to qualify for a series trophy you must race the same boat in the same class for Bay Cup I and Bay Cup II. ORC Club scoring will use performance line circular random scoring. PHRF scoring will use Time on Distance (TOD) scoring.
- 16. **Docking/Launching:** Competitors are welcome to leave their boats in the Inner Harbor of Lakewood Yacht Club for the duration of the Regatta. Launching cranes, ramps, and storage are available at no charge. Accommodations must be made in advance by contacting the Lakewood Yacht Club Harbor Administrator Lynda Hall at 281 474-2540.
- 17. **Advertising:** As a courtesy to our valued race sponsors, no advertising may be displayed on Lakewood Yacht Club premises without prior written permission of the Race Committee.
