- 1) **Rules:** The race will be governed by the rules as defined in “The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008.”
- 2) **Courses:** This is an offshore race, which will start in the Galveston jetties at marker #11 and finish inside the jetties. Spinnaker yachts will sail a triangular course of approximately 85 NM. Non-spinnaker yachts will sail a two leg reaching course of approximately 60 NM.
- 3) **Classes:** ORC Club Spinnaker, ORC Club Non-Spinnaker, One-Design, PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non Spinnaker, and Multihull.
- 4) **Class Size:** A minimum of five boats constitutes a class.

- 6) **Handicapping:** All classes except One Design shall submit a current 2008 rating certificate from a cognizant rating authority prior to the entry deadline. If you have previously submitted the applicable 2008 rating certificate to Lakewood Yacht Club, there is no need to resubmit for this race. Lakewood Yacht Club Race Committee will maintain a master rating certificate file for all boats racing in LYC's races for 2008. Multihull ratings must be obtained through TOMA. These requirements are an unconditional prerequisite for entry. No "club handicaps" will be assigned by the Race Committee. Please contact the following authorities for a rating certificate:

The Race Committee may, in its discretion, accept a late filed rating certificate.

- 7) **Conditions of Entry:** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (Bay Access, Inc., Lakewood Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any yacht or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 8) **Insurance:** Each participating yacht shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent. No skipper or crew member shall participate without signing and turning in to the Race Committee the waiver of liability in this NOR on or before the Skippers' Meeting.
- 9) **Entry Fees:** The Entry Fee is \$45. A \$5 discount is available for US SAILING Members. The Entry Fee is payable by credit card, yacht club reciprocal charge, or check. Entry fees will be refunded if a registrant notifies the Race Committee of the withdrawal prior to the Entry Deadline.
- 10) **Entry Deadline:** The Entry must be submitted by 1700 hours on Wednesday, April 2, 2008. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee but will require a \$75 tax-deductible donation to Bay Access, Inc.

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- 11) **Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers' Meeting.
- 12) **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Race Notice Board of Lakewood Yacht Club located near the west end of the swimming pool.
- 13) **Scoring and Prizes:** Awards shall be presented to no more than 3 places in each class. ORC Club scoring will use performance line offshore scoring. PHRF scoring will use time on distance scoring.
- 14) **Advertising:** As a courtesy to our valued race sponsors, no advertising may be displayed on Lakewood Yacht Club premises without prior written permission of the Race Committee.
