1 ENTRY INFORMATION

1.1 CBYRA Sanction #: 318

1.2 The fee is:

- ♦ \$50 for entries received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 14 May 2015.
- ♦ \$65 for entries received after 2000 hours on Thursday, 14 May 2015, but before 2000 hours on Tuesday, 19 May 2015.

→ Deduct \$5 for each membership in CBYRA and/or USSA.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

PHRF A0	PHRF C	Cal 25	J/105
PHRF A1	PHRF N	J/24	Multihull A
PHRF A2	Cruising	J/30	Multihull B
PHRF B	Alberg 30	J/35	Beach Cats

2.2 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Sunday, 17 May 2015.

3 RULES

3.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*. RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply."

3.2 The Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Sunday, 10 May 2015, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 The schedule of events is:

Sun, 10 May	2000	Sailing Instructions posted to EYC website, Official Notice Board
Tue, 19 May	2000	Entry & registration closes
Sun, 24 May	0955	Warning Signal for the first class

4.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start.

4.3 Starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

5 VENUE & COURSE

The course will be a point-to-point race in the Chesapeake Bay, between St. Michael's and Annapolis.

6 PRIZES

6.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:

- 1st Place for six (6) or more entries;
- 2nd Place for seven (7) or more entries;
- 3rd Place for nine (9) or more entries;
- 4th Place for eleven (11) or more entries.

6.2 Prizes will be awarded during a party at EYC on Sunday, 24 May 2015.

7 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

8 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This is a Clean Race; all competitors are encouraged not to use disposable water bottles. Racers should refrain from throwing trash in the water and recycle all appropriate items.
