# NOTICE OF RACE

### (This Notice of Race may be amended from time to time pursuant to RRS 88.2.)

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)*.
- 1.2. The "class rules" for the purposes of the definition of "rules" are the International Optimist Assoc. Class Rules.
- 1.3. RRS 61.1(a)(2) will be deleted.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix P will apply.

### 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. International Optimist Dinghies may enter by completing entry and consent forms and paying all entry fees.
- 2.2. Red, Blue and White Fleet assignments will be based on the competitor's age on the first day of the regatta.
- 2.3. Competitors must have been born on or after January 1, 2000.
- 2.4. All competitors must be members of their respective national class organization, such as the USODA.

### 3. Registration; Entry Fees

- 3.1. The entry fee will be US \$50. \$10 late fee will be charged for registrations paid after May 18 at 1700.
- 3.2. Enter via Regatta Network at https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet\_registration\_form.php?regatta\_id=10284
- 3.3. A signed waiver (attached) is required. The waiver may be uploaded to Regatta Network, faxed to 310-519-1526, emailed to office@cbyc.org, or turned in at check-in.
- 3.4. The entry fee will include build your own lunches, snack food, and a competitor dinner on Saturday.
- 3.5. Please bring your own water or a reusable water bottle. We will not provide water bottles.

### 4. Format of the Regatta

4.1. There will be championship and green fleets.

NOTE: Racing may be outside the breakwall. A 1545 warning could lead to a race that is not finished until 1645. It is a 45-60 minute tow back from the racing area, meaning that we may not be back to the hoist area until 1745. Please plan departing flights accordingly.

### 6. Measurement

- 6.1. Competitors are allowed to use only one hull, dagger board, rudder (with tiller and extension), mast, boom, sprit and sail during the regatta. Substitution of such equipment shall occur only with the Race Committee's approval.
- 6.2. Boats may be subjected to a safety check prior to launching.

### 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available onsite at check-in.

#### 8. Venue

The racing area may be inside or outside the federal breakwater in the vicinity of Angels Gate lighthouse. The green fleet racing area will be described at the competitors' meeting.

### 9. Penalty System

- 9.1. The penalties for upheld breaches of the certain sailing instructions shall be a ten (10) point scoring penalty for the first infraction of any of them, and for subsequent infractions may be greater up to and including a DSQ at the discretion of the Protest Committee.
- 9.2. The penalty for failing to check out or check in shall be a ten (10) point scoring penalty. The check out and check in process will be described in the sailing instructions.

#### 10. Scoring

10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

### 12. Personal Buoyancy, whistle, and bow line

- 12.1. Each competitor must wear a <u>US Coast Guard approved</u> personal flotation device (PFD), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing. Wet suits, dry suits and inflatable PFD's do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. Failure to wear one will result in a penalty up to and including disqualification at the discretion of the protest committee
- 12.2. Each competitor must have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.
- 12.3. Each boat must have a secure loop in the end of its bow line.

### 13. Safety and Adult Responsibility

- 13.1. An adult (Parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of the each sailor. It is the responsibility solely of this adu to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 13.2. Parents not personally attending any part of the event must ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor, and each competitor shall indicate in writing the parent or adult representative that shall be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.
- 13.3. The designated adult will accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

#### 14. Support boats

- 14.1. All support boats shall register with the race committee.
- 14.2. Each support boat shall have a working VHF radio.
- 14.3. The conduct of registered support boats and all other boats including spectator boats shall be governed by the Sailing Instructions.

#### 15. Prizes

15.1. The following prizes will be awarded:

First through third in Championship fleets,

Top girl, and

Participation awards for all green fleet participants

### 16. Disclaimer of Liability

Participants compete entirely at their own risk. A waiver must be signed by all competitors and their parent/guardian.
