1. GENERAL FORMAT

The 2015 "Tuesday Nite Flight Series" will be a 3 v. 3 team race sailed in Sabots, Lasers, or CFJ's.

2 RULES

- 2.1 The series event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A, Lasers, CFJs and any other class with 2 or more teams.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter on the LIYC Notice Board or by submitting an entry form to LIYC at the start of each series.
- 3.3 Team Composition each team shall consist of 3 boats.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-in on the day of the event.

7. VENUE AND COURSES

- 7.1 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel. The best place to view racing is on the Lido Isle Yacht Club dock or the clubhouse.
- 7.2 Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.
- 7.3 The course may be a box, digital "N" or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

8. FORMAT & SCORING

- 8.1 The format will be determined at the close of registration and will be based on the number of teams registered and the weather conditions. Possible formats include but are not limited to: Round Robin, Split Fleet Round Robin, and Elimination Ladder, followed by quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals. The format to be attempted, contingency formats (if any) and changes to the format will be described fully in the Sailing Instructions and at the Competitor's Meeting on the day of the event.
- 8.2 Scoring: In accordance with Appendix D, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

9. TROPHIES

9.1 Trophies will be awarded on the last day of each series.

10. DISCLAIMER

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
