



**2015 SABOT II NORTH CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**July 15, 2015**



**1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

**2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

- 2.1 Eligibility requirements for boats are they are a Naples Sabot.
- 2.2 Eligibility requirements for competitors are that they are eleven (11) years of age or younger (birthday after 07/15/2003), and that they are a current members of INSA. The top 15 sailors will be invited to participate in the Sabot II Invitational Championships the following week on July 22, 2015 at San Diego Yacht Club.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm. Visit [www.liyc/juniorsailing](http://www.liyc/juniorsailing) to find the registration link. Hand delivered entries will be accepted on Wednesday, July 15<sup>th</sup> until the Skipper's Meeting (10:30am). A \$10 late fee for all entries received after 5pm on Monday, July 13 for a total of \$30.

**3. ENTRY FEE**

\$20 (per boat)  
\$10 Late Fee for all entries received after 5pm on Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>.

**4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

- 4.1 Mandatory Check –In: All competitors must check in Wednesday, July 15 between 9:30am-10:30am. A competitor must check in prior to the Competitor's Meeting.

**\*\*\* Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after race one. There will be no scheduled lunch break if sailing in flights. Sailors should eat either before the start or during their "Bye Race." If flights are not needed, there will be a 30-45 minute lunch break.**

No races will start after 1530

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided during Check-In on the day of the event.

**6. VENUE AND COURSES**

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at Genoa East (please contact Sailing Director for more information).
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Harbor east of LIYC Dock. Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.
- 6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.4 If needed, boats will be divided into flights by the Organizing Authority. All boats must display their flight color ribbon from either the clew of their mainsail or the end of their boom.

## **7. WEIGHTS**

- 7.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event.

## **8. SCORING**

- 8.1 The low point system appendix A of the RRS.

## **9. TROPHIES**

- 9.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race. Trophies will be awarded to the top 15 finishers.

## **10. DISCLAIMER**

- 10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
