1 ENTRY INFORMATION

1.1 CBYRA Sanction #: 324

1.2 The fee is:

- ♦ \$65 for entries received by 2000 hours on Friday, 19 June 2015.
 - ♦ \$95 for entries received after 2000 hours on Friday, 19 June 2015, but before 2000 hours on Wednesday, 24 June 2015.
- ➔ Deduct \$5 for each membership in CBYRA and/or USSA.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes, provided six (6) or more paid registrations are received by 2000 hours on Wednesday, 24 June 2015:

Alerion Express 28 J/70 J/80

2.2 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Wednesday, 24 June 2015.

3 RULES

3.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*. RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*"

3.2 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Wednesday, 10 June 2015, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 The schedule of events is:

Wed, 10 June	2000	Sailing Instructions posted to EYC website, Official Notice Board
Wed, 24 June	2000	Entry & registration closes
Sat, 27 June	1100	Warning Signal for first race
		Subsequent races as signaled by the Race Committee

4.2 The rendezvous location and starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

5 VENUE & COURSES

5.1 Racing area will be in the Chesapeake Bay, in the vicinity of the mouth of the Severn River.

5.2 Competitors will sail drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

6 PRIZES

6.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:

- 1st Place for six (6) or more entries;
- 2nd Place seven (7) or more entries;
- 3rd Place for ten (10) or more entries.

6.2 An awards party will be held at EYC after racing. Prizes will be awarded at the party.

7 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

8 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This is a Clean Regatta; all competitors are encouraged not to use disposable water bottles. Racers should refrain from throwing trash in the water and recycle all appropriate items.
