CLASSES: Three boats are required to form a class. Expected classes include: Sunfish, Lasers, 470's, V-15's, Windsurfers, Catamarans and Portsmouth.

AWARDS: One trophy will be awarded for 3-4 boats, 2 for 5-7, 3 for 8-9, 4 for 10-11, and 5 for 12 or more.

For the Laser Class, District 15 Grand Prix Points will be awarded as described by the ILCA-NA Grand Prix Rules
