

Notice of Race

2015 Laser District 10 Full Rig District Championships June 13-14, 201 Manasquan River Yacht Club, Brielle, NJ

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the International Laser Class Association.

1.2 The organizing authority is the Manasquan River Yacht Club.

2 Inspection and Measurement

Sails, blades, and boats may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. Refer to <http://www.laserinternational.org/sailnos.htm> for detailed instructions.

3 Eligibility and Entry

Competitors must be members of US Sailing, the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association &

4 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

5 Schedule of Events

5.2 Seven races are scheduled for this event. The number of races held each day will be at the discretion of the race committee.

5.3 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on the final day of the regatta.

6 Registration

7 Fees

7.1 The entry fee is \$65 US. A late fee of \$15 US will be charged beginning June 5th.

7.2 The entry fee includes 2 breakfasts, water and snacks, Welcome BBQ on Friday , snacks and food at Sunday awards.

The sailing instructions will be available during on-site check-in.

9 Courses & Racing Area

9.1 Courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

9.2 The racing area will be in the ocean north of the Manasquan Inlet

10 Scoring

10.1 Seven races are scheduled. A minimum of 1 race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10.3 A boat's worst score will be discarded when 5 or more races are completed.

11 Awards

Awards will be given to the top 3 finishers.
