## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 This event is open to boats in the J/105, J/70, J/80, J/30, and J/22 classes.

### 4 CLASSIFICATION

There will be no sailor classification requirements beyond those stated in applicable class rules.

### 5 FEES AND ENTRY

5.1 The entry fee is \$50.00 for all classes.

5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at [www.annapolisyc.com/racing](http://www.annapolisyc.com/racing) by 1900 on Tuesday, 9 June 2015.

5.3 Registrations made after 1900 on Tuesday, 9 June 2015, will be subject to a \$20 late fee.

5.4 To be considered an entry, a boat must complete all requirements of registration.

### 6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The event schedule will be:

13 June	1400	Rendezvous at Tolly Point near mark "1" AH.
	1500	First warning signal for first race of the day
	2000	No warning signal will be made after this time

6.2 Three are scheduled.

### 7 MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

No pre-regatta measurements or inspections will be required.

### 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be posted on the event web site and will be available at the AYC Front Desk by 1900 Thursday 11 June 2015.

### 9 VENUE

9.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.

9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

### 10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward drop mark courses.

### 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.

11.2 Penalties after racing: RRS/US Appendix T, Section B (Post-Race Penalties) will apply.

**12 SCORING**

- 12.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

**13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

**14 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

**15 PRIZES**

- 15.1 Prizes will be given as follows: for 3 or more entrants: 1<sup>st</sup> place  
for 5 or more entrants: 2<sup>nd</sup> place  
for 7 or more entrants: 3<sup>rd</sup> place

15.2 Prizes will be awarded at the AYC Annual Awards Party on Saturday, 21 November 2015.

15.3 Perpetual trophies and additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

**16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**17 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.
