RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2013 – 2016 *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY: Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering [online](#). The Regatta is open to boats of the classes that register in accordance with the Notice of Race, including juniors, centerboards and keelboats. Boats shall be broken into classes as determined by the race committee, based upon registration. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than three like boats, except a multi-class handicap fleet that may be formed at the discretion of the regatta committee. The number and makeup of the PHRF classes will be determined based upon registration. PHRF keelboats must have a current LNKC PHRF certificate number. If you do not have a LNKC PHRF certificate, please apply for one at www.lnkc.com.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: Racing will be Saturday and Sunday only. Races scheduled are **two** for the PHRF keelboats, **five** for the one-design classes (centerboard and keelboat), and unlimited for the Junior course. No races will be started after 1300 hrs. on Sunday.

REGATTA FEES:

Registration and Payment must be received by June 26th to avoid late fees.

Fees:

- \$40 for Keelboats and Centerboards. Late fee \$15 after 6/26
- \$25 for Juniors. Late fee \$10 after 6/26
- \$12 Friday Adult Dinner
- \$6 Friday Child Dinner (under 12)
- \$14 Saturday Adult Dinner; Late fee of \$5 after 6/26
- \$10 Saturday Child Dinner (Under 12); Late fee of \$4 after 6/26
- \$6 Saturday lunch wraps; Can only be pre-ordered
- \$26.50 Friday Stand Up Paddleboard Lesson
- T-Shirts: UV blocking technical fabric. Short sleeve \$25.00/Long sleeve \$30.00.

All fees, meals, T- shirts should be ordered on-line. Limited registration will be available at the event.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board located at the Race Management Center. Copies will be available at registration. PHRF keelboats will race under LNKC Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI).

COURSES: There will be three race areas: Keelboat course will include PHRF keelboats on the down the lake course. One Design keelboats sailing around the buoys along with the Centerboard boats will be on the around-the-buoys course. Junior course will include Optis, Sunfish, Lasers and 420s sailing around the buoys course. Around-the-Buoys courses and Junior courses to be sailed include Windward-Leeward, Triangle and Olympic. Down-the-Lake courses will be as described in the LNKC LSI. All course locations will be in the vicinity of Lake Norman Yacht Club with specific locations to be announced at the Competitors' Meeting. Final fleet and course assignments are at the discretion of the race committee.

SCORING: Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A except that all races shall be scored (changes appendix A2). Keelboats will race under PHRF Time on Distance, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes expected. PHRF classes may be further divided based on the entries received. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta for all fleets.

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by June 26, 2015:
