NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
1.2 The Club 420 Rules also apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Club 420 class.
2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/10611>

3 FEES

The entry fee per boat is \$150. After July 13, the late entry fee increases to \$160.

4 SCHEDULE

4.2 Dates of racing

July 16 0930 Harbor Gun; No race to start after 4 PM

July 17 0900 Harbor Gun; No race to start after 4 PM

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta site after July 1.

6 VENUE

The regatta venue is the Mantoloking Yacht Club, Mantoloking, NJ. Races will be sailed on Barnegat Bay south of the Yacht Club.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward with marks to port.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A.

8.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This modifies RRS A2.

9 MEASUREMENT

All competitors are responsible for their boats being in compliance with C420 class rules.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

10.1. Team leaders, coaches, other support personnel and spectators shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for a race until all boats have finished that race, or until the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment

10.2. Coach/support and spectator boats shall follow the instructions of race committee and race management boats. Coach/support boats are responsible for helping **all** boats in distress, not just their own.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

11.1. Trophies will be awarded to the first 8 teams (skipper and crew).

11.2. The winning team will receive the perpetual trophy for the C420 NJ State Championship. This trophy must be returned in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Gift.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
