<u>INVITATION:</u> You are cordially invited to participate in the 2015 Dillon Open Regatta (DOR) hosted by the Dillon Yacht Club (DYC), a benefit for Dillon Yacht Club Junior Sailing program at the Nation's highest yacht club.

ELIGIBILITY/FLEETS/CLASSES

Open to all Keelboats, Jr Sailors participating in the SAIL CO Jr Tour, and Lasers. Fleet/Class racing will be available to those Classes registering 5 or more boats. Classes not able to form a fleet will race in their appropriate PHRF or Portsmouth division. Boats racing in the PHRF Fleet must have a current Sailing Association of Intermountain Lakes (SAIL) PHRF certificate. Annual Certificates, which include membership to S.A.I.L. are \$15, or temporary one-regatta certificate is \$5, can be purchased during check-in. For non S.A.I.L. PHRF members, ratings will be determined by the OA/PRO. PHRF ratings are available on the SAIL website. Classes may be started together but will be scored separately.

RULES

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the US Sailing current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Sailing Instructions will be available during registration check in. The Dillon Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

<u>COURSES:</u> Keel Boats/Lasers courses will be sailed in the main portion of Lake Dillon. Jr's will sail in Dillon Bay.

NUMBER OF RACES PLANNED: 10 races are planned for the keel boats/lasers; more may be sailed for the Jr's. Races will be run back to back and one race shall constitute a regatta.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the US Sailing current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the sailing instructions, will be used.

TROPHIES: First, second and third places trophies will be awarded to the winning boat in each class with 5 or more boats.

SPECTATOR BOATS: For the non-racer that wants to watch the racing on the water there will be a total of four spectator boats that will depart at 11:45 and 1:30 each day for a 90-minute excursion. The boats will accommodate 10 people each and the cost is \$25 per adult or child per ride.

FACILITIES: Dillon and Frisco Bay Marinas have overnight slips, showers and restrooms that are available to all regatta participants and guests. Small boats may launch and utilize the Dillon Beach adjacent to the launch ramp. Please contact the <u>Dillon Marina</u> office at (970) 468-5100 or the <u>Frisco Marina</u> office at 970-668-4334 for slip availability. Trailer storage will be provided by the Town of Dillon and designated at the time of check in by obtaining a trailer permit at no charge from the Dillon Marina office. ALL BOATS MUST COMPLY WITH STATE MANDATED AQUATIC NUISANCE INSPECTION GOING INTO AND COMING OUT OF THE WATER.
