

Notice of Race 2015 Halloween Regatta October 9 - 11, 2015

The organizing authority is the Augusta Sailing Club at Strom Thurmond Lale Clarks Hill.

Rules: Racing is governed by the US Sailing Association (USS^) R \CING RULES OF SAILING (RRS) for 2013-2016, Individual Class Rules and Sailing ' \tag{SIIIng (RRS)} to be posted online at halloween.augustasailingclub.org and at registration).

• Optimist Class Green Fleet: Registered Optimist Class yoak with hulls older than 1995 are *grandfathered* and **Will Not** come under current class rules.

Classes: Racing is open to any one-design class boat. E. pected Classes include: MC Scow, C Scow, E Scow, JY-15, Lightning, J22, J24, Laser (Jr & Sr). Optimist (All levels), and Sunfish (Jr & Sr). Four boats shall constitute a class Racing is all o open to PHRF classes for Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker. PHRF boats much have a current ASC PHRF certificate and sail in compliance with that certificate.

Scoring: The low point scoring syste Rule A 2 will apply modified so that each boat's score shall be the total of their race scores in all races. One race will constitute a regatta. PHRF classes will be scored based on corrected times calculated by the time-on-time method.

Fees: See Schedule of Activities and Fees. Register online by Midnight October 1 and save \$\$\$\$. Members of US Sailing vill be given a \$5 discount. US Sailing membership cards are required for verification.

NOTICE – ALL PARTICIPANTS on Launch & Recovery:

- It is your responsibility to leave the dock in time to make it to the rac sou se. We race anywhere from one half mile, and up to 4 miles from the launching site, so please consider this when you make plans about getting to the race course.
- We launch boats for 90 minutes on Saturday and 60 mir utes on Sunday morning for your convenience. The assisted launching ends 30 mir utes on Sunday morning for your convenience.
