Keelboats / Large Multihulls: July 15-19, 2015
J-70: July 18-19, 2015



Invitation: You are cordially invited to attend the 2015 Corpus Christi Yacht Club Race Week.

Keelboats / Large Multihulls: Four day event to be conducted on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Wednesday will consist of one race using the normally scheduled Wednesday night race. Friday, boats will be assigned CCYC 420s, and race in multiple races inside the marina. Each boat is allowed to have at maximum two members of the boat's crew participating in at least two of the other scheduled regatta days sail on the 420 Friday night, and boats may substitute crews on the 420 between races Friday night. 420 races will be combined, and the overall race score for Friday night will count as one race towards Regatta score. Saturday and Sunday racing will consist of multiple W/L races each day. Working sails fleets may be given a combination of W/L races and fixed mark races on Saturday and Sunday.

J-70: Two day event to be conducted on Saturday and Saturday. Multiple W/L races each day in the CC Bay off Emerald Beach.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS 2013-2016.

Eligibility and Entry:

Keelboats / Large Multihulls: The regatta is open to any yacht that holds a current PHRF certificate or provisional rating from South Texas PHRF (MORF) or has applied to the CCYC Race Chairman for a temporary rating. The CCYC Race Chairman may assign a temporary rating to any yacht for the purpose of this regatta and such decision on a yacht's rating is final. For the formation of a class in this regatta, a minimum of three (3) vessels will be required.

J-70: The regatta is open to all J-70's. For the formation of a class in this regatta, a minimum of three (3) vessels will be required.

Entry Deadline: 7:00pm, Monday, July 13, 2015. Registrations filed after this time may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Chairman (Robert Kelley 361-549-2910) and if accepted, shall be assessed a \$10 late entry fee.

Wednesday night's race will count as one race, Friday night's 420 racing will be combined and the overall standings will count as one race, and each individual race held on Saturday and Sunday will count as one individual race each.
