## **NOTICE OF RACE**

This regatta is held in honor of long time Lido 14 and Laser sailboat racer Roy Woolsey, who lived to the grand age of 90, sailing right up to the end. Roy lived and sailed in a manner that was held in the highest regard. In honor of Roy, we ask that all competitors bring their best sportsmanship and conduct to his regatta; as we know Roy would do himself, and would expect of others.

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY: All Lido 14 skippers must be current members of the Lido 14 Class Association, or be guests of the organizers of this event. All Laser racers are invited to participate. A and B level fleets will be formed by the RC depending on the number of entries. Eligible skippers may sign up at www.regattanetwork.com; or by completing the entry at the LIYC Board Room prior to the event. The fees are \$15 for Lasers, and \$25 for Lido 14 (skipper and crew).

**SCHEDULE:** Five Races are scheduled. The schedule of the regatta is as follows:

Entry/Registration 11:00 AM to 11:30 AM LIYC Board Room

Skippers Meeting 11:45 AM LIYC Patio in front of the Board Room

Race #1, #2 12:01 PM First Warning

Ten Minute Break after Race #2, if time and conditions permits

Race #3, #4, #5 immediately following the Break

Awards Celebration including drinks and clam chowder, at the Yacht Club immediately after the last race.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

VENUE: Racing will be in the portions of Balboa Bay south of Lido Isle, or in the "Turning Basin" as announced at the Meeting

**FACILITIES:** Visiting boats may use the Genoa Boat Gardens to launch their boats. The Boat Gardens are located at Via Lido Soud and Genoa streets, which is 12 blocks west of Lido Isle Yacht Club. The Boat Garden gates will be open from 9:30 AM until 6:00 PM. The Boat Garden offers both a ramp suitable for hand or auto launching, and a hoist. Boats wishing to use the hoist must provide their own internal lifting sling. There is limited space for trailers to stay for the day in the Genoa West Boat Garden. Everyone is requested to park their cars and trailers legally and to not block traffic and driveways.

**SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System shall apply. One completed race shall constitute a series.

COMPLIMENTARY drinks and clam chowder will be served at the Awards Celebration immediately after sailing.
