### RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority for this regatta is Birmingham Sailing Club.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016. Measurement requirements do not apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Applicants for all classes must be rising high school seniors or younger at the start of the regatta.
- 2.2 Competitors are required to supply their own boats.

**Classes:** International Optimist Dinghy: Red, Blue, White, and Green  
(Green fleet will be coached by Holly Murray, Southern Yacht Club Junior Coach)  
Laser Class-Full, Radial, 4.7  
Collegiate 420 (no spinnaker or trapeze)

**Entry fees for each class:** \$55.00-single hand includes racing fee and meals for skippers  
\$80.00-double hand includes racing fee and meals for skipper and crew

**Additional meals:** \$25.00 for extra meal package (includes Saturday lunch & dinner, Sunday breakfast & lunch), \$10.00 for extra dinner, \$5.00 for extra lunch or breakfast

**Deadline for Registration is August 19, 2015**  
**Late fee of \$10.00 will apply after the registration deadline**

#### **4. Sailing Instructions**

#### **5. Scoring -**

5.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the RRS shall apply.  
5.2 As many races as possible will be sailed. At least one race must be completed to constitute a Series. If seven or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score will be discarded.

#### **6. Lifejackets**

6.1 All competitors shall wear, while on the water, a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing.  
6.2 Each competitor shall have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.
