NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 This event is open to boats with a valid PHRF/Chesapeake 4P rating.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There will be no sailor classification requirements beyond those stated in applicable class rules.

5 FEES AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$50.00 for all classes.
- 5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at www.annapolisyc.com/racing by 11 August 2015.
- 5.3 Registrations made after 11 August 2015 will be subject to a \$20 late fee.
- 5.4 To be considered an entry, a boat must complete all requirements of registration.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The event schedule will be:

	1400	First warning signal for first race of the day
	1830	No warning signal will be made after this time

6.2 Three races are scheduled.

7 MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

No pre-regatta measurements or inspections will be required.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be posted on the event website www.annapolisyc.com/racing and will be available at the AYC Front Desk by 1700 Thursday 13 August 2015.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.
- 9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward drop mark courses.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.
- 11.2 Penalties after racing: RRS/US Appendix T, Section B (Post-Race Penalties) will apply.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. 12.2
- 12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores; this changes Appendix A2.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

15 **PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: for 3 or more entrants: 1st place for 5 or more entrants: 2nd place 15.1

for 7 or more entrants: 3rd place

15.2 Perpetual trophies and additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

16 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.


