1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Racing rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats holding a valid 2015 Monterey Bay PHRF rating.
- 2.2 One-Design boats are invited to participate as a class. If five boats of a single type register, they will form a class.
- 2.3 Based upon their PHRF rating, sails used while racing and number of crew, boats may enter one of the following Divisions:

A Fleet (PHRF <88) B Fleet (PHRF>89) Jib and Main (PHRF <182) Jib and Main (PHRF >181)

The Organizing Authority reserves the right to modify the Divisions based upon entries received.

- 2.4 Eligible boats may only enter on-line at SCYC.org before 1000 hours on Saturday, September 12, 2015.
- 2.5 A completed Float Plan <u>must</u> be submitted as a part of registration. The float plan may be on a form provided by the Organizing Authority and must be submitted prior to the competitor's meeting on Saturday, September 12, 2015.
- 2.6 The organizing authority reserves the right to reject an entry based on its sole opinion of the seaworthiness of the boat.

3.0 Fees

3.1 The regular entry fee is \$50. For all entries received after 1200 hours on **Friday**, **September 11** a late entry fee of \$75 will apply.

4.0 Berthing in Monterey

- 4.1 This Race is being coordinated with the Santa Cruz and Back Regatta sponsored by the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club on the same date with the expectation that berths will be available for the Santa Cruz boats in the slips vacated by the Monterey boats participating in the Regatta, and the Santa Cruz berths will be available for the Monterey boats in the slips vacated by the Santa Cruz boats are cruz boats participating in the Regatta.
- 4.2 Berthing may also be arranged directly with MPYC (mpyc.org) or the Monterey Harbormaster at: http://monterey.org/en-us/departments/harbormarina.aspx

5.0 Schedule

- 5.1 A competitor's meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours Saturday, September 12, 2015 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 5.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Saturday, September 12, is 1225 hours.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Sunday, September 13, is 1225 hours.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on-line on the SCYC.org web site on or before 1100 hrs. on September 11 and also at the competitor's meeting.

7.0 Venue & Course

- 7.1 Racing will be in open waters of Monterey Bay between Santa Cruz and Monterey.
- 7.2 On Saturday September 12, the race will start in Santa Cruz and finish in Monterey.
- 7.3 On Sunday September 13, the race will start in Monterey and finish in Santa Cruz.



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7.4 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

8.0 Scoring

- 8.1 One race is required to complete the regatta.
- 8.2 There will be no throw-outs.
- 8.3 Scoring will be based on 2015 Monterey Bay PHRF ratings and will be scored time on distance.

9.0 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

9.1 The Race Committee may broadcast information about the day's racing on VHF 68. All boats will be required to check in before the start and before finishing. Please note that at check-in we will be asking for the total number of people on board, and if there has been any change from the online registration you will be asked to switch to VHF 72 to provide the new information. Check-in is not complete until confirmation is received from the Race Committee. Boats failing to check in with the Race Committee, including providing number of people on board, on VHF 68 will be scored DNC. This changes RRS

10.0 Prizes


- 10.1 Prizes will be awarded to each Division for first place and additional places based upon the number of entries at the discretion of the organizing authority. Awards will be at the SCYC clubhouse after racing on Sunday.
- 10.2 Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta.

11.0 Disclaimer of Liability

- 11.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 11.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.


