NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Herreshoff 12.5, Harbor 20, and Alerion 28 classes.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There will be no sailor classification requirements beyond those stated in applicable class rules.

5 FEES AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$50.
- 5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at www.annapolisyc.com/racing by Wednesday, 9 September, 2015
- 5.3 Registrations made after Wednesday, 9 September will be subject to a \$25 late fee.
- 5.4 To be considered an entry, a boat must complete all requirements of registration.
- 5.5 The fee includes racing and awards ceremony afterward at AYC.

6 SCHEDULE

6.2 Three are scheduled.

7 MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

No pre-regatta measurements or inspections will be required.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on the event website and at the AYC Front Desk by 1700 Thursday 10 September, 2015. They will also be available from the RC signal boat at the start.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.
- 9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward or triangular drop mark courses.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.
- 11.2 Penalties after racing: RRS/US Appendix T, Section B (Post-Race Penalties) and Section D (Arbitration) will apply.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place in each class.
- 15.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.


