Wildlife Commission and U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations. One race is planned for the Michelob Ultra Regatta; one completed race will constitute the regatta.

<u>Eligibility.</u> The Regatta is open to any Yacht holding a current NC-PHRF. Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at WWW.nyra.org, and paying the required fees to NYRA. Late entries will be accepted via online registration until 7:30 pm September 5.

<u>Classes.</u> A minimum of three boats will constitute a class. There will be classes for spinnaker, non-spinnaker, cruising, and multi hull fleets. Each fleet may be broken into multiple classes based on PHRF rating, depending on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

Scoring. Michelob Ultra Regatta - PHRF handicap system scored with a pursuit start.

<u>PHRF:</u> A NC-PHRF Rating Request form that can be submitted for boats that do not have a current rating is available at http://www.ncphrf.com/. If you need to apply for a rating, please send the completed and signed Request Form and check no later than 1 week prior to the regatta to the address on the form

The John Walsh Memorial Oar Race, organized by Fairfield Harbour Yacht Club, is a Distance race from New Bern to Oriental, NC. which operates as a perfect compliment to the Michelob Ultra, and allows boats to race from New Bern to Oriental (the starting point for the Michelob Ultra) on the Saturday before the Michelob Ultra. The warning signal for the Oar Race is scheduled for 11:00 am on Saturday, September 5. The Michelob Ultra Regatta, organized by the Neuse Yacht Racing Association, is a Distance Race with a Pursuit Start, beginning in Oriental and finishing in New Bern. The warning signal for the Michelob Ultra Regatta is scheduled for 10:00 am, Sunday, September 6. The Start for the Oar Race will be in the vicinity of Government Markers 17 and 19 on the Neuse River; the start of the Michelob Ultra Regatta will be in the Neuse River outside the entrance to Oriental Harbor.

Both the Michelob Ultra Regatta and the Oar Race are independent events; racers may register and race in either event, or both. Awards for the Oar Race will be held at the post race social in Oriental, Saturday, September 5; Awards for the Michelob Ultra Regatta will be held at the Post Race Social in New Bern on September 6.
