- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 All boats shall have a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 06 and 16.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions take precedence. This changes rule 63.7
- 1.4 All boats shall carry the required safety equipment conforming to government regulations that apply in the racing area.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta will be PHRF-MA.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to all boats with a VALID 2015 PHRF-MA certificate.
- 3.2 Registration is available online at http://www.regattanetwork.com online is the only method to register for this regatta.

4. ENTRY FEES

4.1 The entry fee is \$50 for yachts entered by 9/8/2015. Entries after that date shall pay a \$25 late fee.
