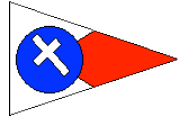

2015 JACK & JILL REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 20, 2015

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. Rule A2 will be changed; no race will be excluded from a boat's score.
- 1.4. Changes to the Rules will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 2.1. Boats holding a valid 2015 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 2.2. There will be PHRF divisions as follows: spinnaker, non-spinnaker and families with children 12 and under, and families with children 13 and older. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except for the family division. Final division assignments will be made at the competitors meeting.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may only register online at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/11183> prior to 1035 hours Sunday, September 20, 2015.

3. Fees

- 3.1. The early entry fee is \$45 if registered by September 17, 2015. The regular entry fee is \$60.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. A competitors meeting will be held at 1100 hours on September 20, 2015 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3. One race is scheduled. The course will be selected from the current SCORE courses.
- 4.4. There will be an awards ceremony and prize giving at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting. They may be posted earlier on the SCYC website.

6. Venue

- 6.1. Racing will be around fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 3.5-mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7. Courses

- 7.1. Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

8. Scoring

- 8.1. One race will constitute a series.

9. Prizes

- 9.1. Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
