



NOTICE OF RACE
2015 Tour de Canyon Race
HILL COUNTRY YACHT CLUB (HCYC)
Saturday September 19, 2015



Eligibility: This is an open race. All PHRF boats are eligible. Yacht club membership is **not** a requirement for race entry. Non-HCYC member entrants and crews are welcome to the HCYC facility.

Rules: This race will be governed by the RACING RULES OF SAILING 2013-2016, this Notice of Race, and by the current version of the Canyon Lake Sailing Instructions as modified for HCYC use.

Possible Classes: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, Catalina 22, Big Boat, Cruiser, and Portsmouth. Three (3) or more boats may constitute a fleet. Actual fleets will be set and announced at the Skipper's Meeting. Fleets of less than 3 boats may be set at the discretion of Race Committee.

Races & Course: This is a single long distance course based on wind conditions on race day. The course will be set at the discretion of the Race Committee and will be explained at the skippers meeting prior to the race. There will be two courses, a long course and a short course.

Trophies: Trophies will be based upon registrations received per class. 3-4 boats = 1 trophy; 5-7 = 2; 8-9 = 3; 10-15 = 4. The minimum number of trophies per fleet is one (1).

Timetable: End of Regular Registration: 11:59 PM, Friday, September 18, 2015. Late registration will be taken online and at the skipper's meeting, until 11:30 am, Saturday, September 19, 2015. Skipper's Meeting: 11:00 AM, Saturday, September 19, 2015

Start and Finish of Race: Start 1:00 PM, Saturday, September 19, 2015. Starting sequence begins at 12:55 PM. Racers crossing finish line after 6 pm are requested to take their own time, sound their own horn, and report their time to PRO at 830-730-3010. Results presentation will be made at the HCYC clubhouse approximately 6:45 pm.

Results Presentation: All racers and crew are invited to the HCYC clubhouse, after the race, for BYOB refreshments. Club decision about a possible dinner or pot luck supper will be made closer to race day. Please note the Hill Country Yacht Club does not serve beer or alcoholic beverages. All racers, crew, and other guests are welcome to **BYOB**.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS #4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
