

# 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Racing rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.

## 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all class legal 505 boats.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may <u>only</u> enter on-line at SCYC.org or at the event web site at: <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/11243</u> before 1000 hours, September 19, 2015.
- 2.3. During entry competitors may provide a phone number or email address for the purpose of receiving Official Regatta Notices electronically. This is optional, and these contact points will not be used for any non-regatta purposes.

### 3. Fees

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$25.
- 3.2. Entry includes dolly storage in the dry storage area on an available space basis.
- 3.3. Entry does <u>NOT</u> include parking at Santa Cruz Harbor for cars and trailers, a modest fee will be charged by the Harbor through their machines located in the parking lot. All boats in the dry storage area must be willing to be moved by other boat owners, SCYC staff and members. Trailers may be stored at the off-site lot at the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> and Brannon St. approximately 1 miles from SCYC. Please contact the Harbormaster or her deputy for instructions.

### 4. Schedule

- 4.1. Saturday, September 19<sup>st</sup>
  - 4.1.1. Three (3) races are scheduled.
  - 4.1.2. The first 5O5 race will follow the last start of the first race of the SCYC One-Design fleet.
  - 4.1.3. Appetizers at the SCYC Clubhouse after racing.

### 5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on-line and at the regatta shed in the dry storage area.

### 6. Venue & Courses

- 6.1. The venue is the Monterey Bay within four (4) miles of Walton Lighthouse at Santa Cruz Harbor.
- 6.2. Courses shall be Windward/Leeward around inflatable set marks.

### 7. Prizes

7.1. Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of regular entries.

### 8. Disclaimer of Liability

- 8.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 8.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 8.3. All competitors under the age of 18 must have a waiver signed by their parent or guardian.
