**DIRECTIONS:** **From I-26, Exit 102-A** onto Highway 60 (Lake Murray Blvd) continue through Irmo for 3.9 miles. Then Right on SC 6 for 0.5 miles, Left on Shuler Road to CSC.  
**From I-20**, East or West: Exit to I-26 west and follow the directions above.

<b>Sailing instructions</b>	Available at the CSC Clubhouse Friday evening and Saturday morning. Time limits of RRS62 and 66 are modified so that no filings under these rules will be allowed past the protest time limit or 30 minutes from the relevant incident on the last day of the regatta.		
<b>Definition of Junior</b>	Junior classes are defined in the 2015 SAYRA Junior Championship Series Notice of Regatta		
<b>Courses</b>	Courses will as described in the Sailing Instructions available at the CSC Clubhouse Friday evening and Saturday morning.		
<b>Scoring</b>	One race shall constitute a regatta. The low point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS, will apply, except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races (no throw outs). Need 5 boats to make a class.		
<b>Prizes</b>	The number of trophies will be approximately one for every four entries.		
<b>Note</b>	The Organizing Authority (CSC) retains the right to amend this NOR prior to November 4, 2015.
