1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Any changes to the RRS will be addressed in the Sailing Instructions (Alternate Penalties, etc.)

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- **2.1** The regatta is open to all one-design classes. Expected Classes: Thistle, Flying Scot, J22 (SE circuit event), Buccaneer, and Open. All other classes with 5 or more registered boats will have separate starts.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering during the registration period.

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A (The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016) will apply, except that a boat's final score shall be the sum of all races, with no throw-outs. This changes rule A2.
- 7.2 Boats not sailing in a one-design fleet will be scored using the US Sailing Portsmouth Yardstick.
- 7.3 Five (5) are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.
- 7. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded per class as follows: 1st 3nd for 5 or more boats including crew trophies.
