

Instructions on Using the Equipment Limitation Stickers

All boats shall apply Equipment Limitation Stickers according to the instruction below. The stickers can be obtained from the Measurement Desk in or near the measurement tent as from Thursday 21 July 2016 15:00.

Please ensure that equipment is;

- DRY
- CLEAN

BEFORE you apply the stickers to any item of equipment!!

Please ensure that stickers are placed according to the instructions below.

Keep in mind that all stickers should be clearly visible to the Equipment Inspection Team.

HULL – Sticker serial number 01

Place on the port side of the stern.

CENTERBOARD – Sticker serial number 02

Place on the very top of the centerboard, along the centerline such that no part of the sticker enters the casing.

RUDDER BLADE – Sticker serial number 03

Place on the very top of the rudder blade, along the centerline such that no part of the sticker enters the casing.

MAST BOTTOM – Sticker serial number 04

Place on the front face of the mast, at the bottom of the section. Ensure sticker is clear of any rigging or attachments.

MAST MIDDLE – Sticker serial number 05

Place on the front face of the mast, at the bottom of the section. Ensure sticker is clear of any rigging or attachments.

MAST TOP – Sticker serial number 06

Place on the front face of the mast, at the bottom of the section. Ensure sticker is clear of any rigging or attachments.

BOOM – Sticker serial number 07

Place on the port side of the boom at the outer end. Ensure sticker is clear of any rigging or attachments.

GENNAKER POLE – Sticker serial number 8

Place on front end of gennaker pole

SAILS

All sails may be stamped or signed by an inspector.

NOTE – This form and all unused stickers shall be returned to the Measurement Desk

- 1.1 I understand that these items may not be substituted at any time during the event without prior written consent of the Race Committee.
- 1.2 It is my sole responsibility to ensure that the equipment I use for this event shall comply with the class rules at all times and that the equipment may be checked for class rule compliance at any time during the event.
