1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS) 2013–2016.
- 1.2. RRS 61.1(a)(2) will be deleted.
- 1.3. RRS Appendix P will apply
- 1.4. US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. International Optimist Dinghies may enter by completing entry and consent forms and paying all entry fees.
- 2.2. Red, Blue and White Fleet assignments will be based on the competitor's age on the first day of the regatta.
- 2.3. Competitors must have been born on or after January 1, 2000.
- 2.4. All competitors must be members of their respective national class organization, such as the USODA.

3. Registration; Entry Fees

- 3.1. The entry fee will be US \$50, if done via Regatta Network on or before Nov 30. Late entries will be \$60.

- 3.3. The registration fee includes morning and lunch snacks each day, chili with fixings on Saturday, and something after racing on Sunday. Please bring a water bottle.

4. Format of the Regatta

4.1. There will be championship and green fleets.

6. Measurement

- 6.1. Competitors are allowed to use only one hull, dagger board, rudder (with tiller and extension), mast, boom, sprit and sail during the regatta. Substitution of such equipment shall occur only with the Race Committee's approval.
- 6.2. Boats may be subjected to a safety check prior to launching.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available onsite at check-in and may be available at www.cbyc.org.

8. Venue

The championship fleet racing area will be in the vicinity of the federal breakwater inside Angels Gate lighthouse. The specific racing areas, one for championship fleet and another for green fleet, will be described at the competitor's meeting.

9. Penalty System

9.1. The penalties for upheld breaches of the certain sailing instructions shall be a ten (10) point scoring penalty for the first infraction of any of them, and for subsequent infractions may be greater up to and including a DSQ at the discretion of the Protest Committee.

10. Scoring

10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

12. Personal Buoyancy, whistle, and bow line

- 12.1. Each competitor must wear a US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing.
- 12.2. Each competitor must have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.
- 12.3. Each boat must have a secure loop in the end of its bow line.

13. Safety and Adult Responsibility

- 13.1. An adult (Parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of the each sailor. It is the responsibility solely of this adult to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 13.2. Parents not personally attending any part of the event must ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor, and each competitor shall indicate in writing the parent or adult representative that shall be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.
- 13.3. The designated adult will accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

14. Support boats

- 14.1. Each support boat shall have a working VHF radio.
- 14.2. The conduct of support boats and all other boats including spectator boats shall be governed by the Sailing Instructions.

15. Prizes

15.1. The following prizes will be awarded: First through third in Championship fleets, Top girl, and Participation awards for all green fleet participants

16. Disclaimer of Liability

Participants compete entirely at their own risk. A waiver must be signed by all competitors and their parent/guardian.

17. Holiday fun...

- 17.1 Younger siblings are welcome to participate in the CBYC children's holiday party. The party is from 1200 to 1500 on Saturday. Santa will arrive at 1330.
- 17.2 The Port of Los Angeles boat parade will take place Saturday evening. Competitors or their families may wish to view or participate in the parade. There may be a large spectator boat available. Call the club office for details.
- 17.3 On Saturday evening, there will be chili, cornbread, and salad for \$7 for adults it is included for the sailors. Feel free to relax at the club and keep a lookout for the tail end of the holiday parade.
