Notice Of Race

1. RULES

1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is CYC.
2. The Sailing Instructions will delete RRS 40 and replaced with:
"Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment."
3. Fleet 1 Articles of Association for J/105 will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at: <http://www.cyc.org/racing> OR <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/11521>
 2. All sailboats eligible to race in SF- YRA , BAMA or one design events can participate in this series. The regatta will include PHRF, Non-Spinnaker, One-Design, and Multihull divisions.
 3. One Design fleets of 5 or more may have separate scoring; 8 or more separate starts.
 4. "Non-Spinnaker" divisions are for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats if accepted by the Race Committee. Wyliecats and similar boats shall race in the Spinnaker division. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification, particularly boats not racing in the configuration for which they received their NC-PHRF rating.
PHRF ratings of Knarrs and AE28s shall be adjusted if raced Non-Spinnaker. A boat without a current rating (or one- design) may be assigned a less favorable rating by the Race Committee.
- 3. FEES:** Entry Fee is \$120 (\$20 late fee after Jan 11th 6pm). Entry fee for the February weekend only will be \$70. Entry fee for the one-day Rob Moore Memorial on February 20 will be \$40.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

1. Four races are scheduled in the regatta, with one race each day. Jan 16-17, Feb 20-21.
2. First Warning Signal is 1pm on all race days.

5. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** will be available no later than Jan 13th on the web site at: <http://www.cyc.org/racing> OR <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/11521>
6. **VENUE & COURSES:** The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
7. **PENALTY SYSTEM:** Appendix T1 section A will apply and will be included in the SI's.
8. **SCORING**
 1. Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and one design Class Rules.
 2. A minimum of two races constitutes a series. There will be no throw-outs.
 3. The Aotea Team Trophy will be awarded to the best performing three-boat team from a single yacht club sailing in different divisions. Performance will be calculated by taking the sum, for each team, of its members' average Aotea score for each race not abandoned, calculated according to the formula $S = (1 - (\text{Points} - 1) / \text{Boats In Class}) / 100$.
9. **RADIO COMMUNICATIONS:** The Race Committee may use the VHF 71 radio to communicate information about time to start and recalls.
10. **PRIZES:** Daily and series trophies will be awarded. Additional special trophies, and discretionary fun prizes, will be awarded to those boats racing on February 21.
11. **INSURANCE:** Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy.
