# Regatta Safety Plan

#### **Emergency Operations**

Police, fire, medical, and rescue organizations are located near the yacht club and have very quick response times. In addition, the club has life rings, fire extinguishers, basin ladders, and cardiac defibrillators on-site. Competitors and visitors are asked to familiarize themselves with the location of the nearest rescue equipment in the yacht basin after docking/rafting their boats. Automatic cardiac defibrillators can be found in the Main Club House and in the EastBasin next to the boat hoists. Additional medical equipment can be located at the JuniorSailingCenter (first building on the right as you enter the yacht club property from the main entrance), the pool area, and RYC committee boats.
