

## Why We Sail

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The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society is the world's largest voluntary health organization dedicated to funding blood cancer research and providing education and patient services.

- Every three minutes, someone in the United States is diagnosed with a blood cancer. Every ten minutes someone dies from these cancers.
- An estimated 1,185,053 people in the US are living with, or are in remission from, leukemia, Hodgkin lymphoma, NHL, or myeloma.
- The five-year relative survival rate for patients with Hodgkin lymphoma has more than doubled from 40% between 1960 and 1963, to almost 87.7% between 2004 and 2010. The five-year survival rate for NHL patients rose from 31% between 1960 and 1963; to just over 71.4% between 2004 and 2010.
- From 2004-2010, the five-year relative survival rates overall were 70% overall, 91.8% for children and adolescents younger than 15 years, and 93% for children younger than 5 years.

## NOTICE OF RACE LEUKEMIA CUP REGATTA JUNE 24 - 26, 2016

<u>RULES:</u> The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing Association and Class Guidelines, In the event there is a conflict, the sailing instructions will govern.

**ENTRIES:** To enter the regatta, go to <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u>. Late entry may be made after midnight June 22, 2016.

FLEETS: A minimum of three yachts of the same design will constitute a fleet. A fleet of fewer than the required number of entries will be regarded as having failed to form and may be assigned to another fleet, or an entry fee refund may be requested.

ONE DESIGN LINE: Expected fleets include (but not limited to)

A-Cat,Ensign,J22,J24,J70,J80,J105,J109,Lightning,Viper. If there is a fleet you are interested in but not listed please contact the Regatta Chair.

**<u>DINGHY LINE:</u>** Expected classes include Club 420, Lightning and Optimist. The number of races on this line will be at the discretion of the PRO.

<u>PURSUIT LINE:</u> Expected classes include Pursuit PHRF Spinnaker, Pursuit PHRF Non-Spinnaker and Pursuit HYC Club Handicap Non-Spinnaker. The intention is to have two races on Saturday and one on Sunday.

MEASUREMENT: Yachts racing PHRF MUST have a current PHRF rating certificate. Yachts without a valid PHRF Certificate will be assigned to the HYC Club Handicap Class. Yachts racing One Design will comply with all requirements of the relevant class association.

<u>SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:</u> The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Competitor's Briefing and the Club Office after the Competitor's Briefing.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to Competitors will be posted on the official race information notice board located in the breezeway adjacent to the offices at the Houston Yacht Club.

<u>SCORING:</u> The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. One race will constitute a series. No scores will be excluded. This modifies RRS Appendix A.

<u>PRIZES:</u> Prizes will be awarded by fleet. The number of prizes in each class will depend on the number entries.

DOCKING, LAUNCHING, AND ACCOMMODATIONS: Come spend the weekend! The HYC harbor is ready for your boat. Rooms are also available in the club house, first come, first serve. Please check with the club staff for availability and rates. Participants are welcome to leave boats on the front lawn, in trailer areas and on dock for the duration of the regatta. Accommodations can be made for early arrivals by checking with the HYC office. Launching cranes and ramps are available at no charge. Club regulations prohibit the parking of campers and buses on the club grounds.

RACE AREA: The PHRF,J105,J109,& J80's line will be located with Bayport Ship Channel to the North, Houston Ship Channel on the East, Seabrook shoreline on the West and San Leon shoreline to the South.
