

Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat. A current PHRF of the Chesapeake certificate is

required for all handicap racers. Separate starts are planned for the divisions below.

The Race Committee may combine starts for some classes, depending on the number of

entrants.

CRCA classes qualify for CRCA Boat if the Year; CRCA Fun Classes will use pursuit starts; CHESSS classes do not qualify for CBYRA high point. Each class must have at least 3 starters to be scored separately. If less they will be scored as part of the PHRF division appropriate to their ratings. The 210s are required to provide their own support boat.

Rendezvous: At 0930 in vicinity of Region 3 Mark A "Hackett's Can" GC-1. Check in required. If

conditions warrant, the start may be moved north of the Bay Bridge. Some CRCA FUN

pursuit starts will rendezvous near Rock Creek (Patapsco R.) and Rock Hall.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee

Signals: First warning at 1030. Class flags as defined in the 2016 CBYRA Green Book. Intended

starting sequence will be posted by 2400 on Thursday 12 May at giys.gibsonisland.com.

A distance race of 10-25 nm around CBYRA region 2 & 3 marks. The courses will Courses:

> be displayed using placards on the RC signal boat and announced on on VHF 72. The courses for CRCA fun classes will be predetermined in amended sailing instructions available on line before May 1, 2016. The starts for Northern Bay CRCA classes will be

conducted by the CRCA.

Finish: Between Region 2 Mark T "Baltimore Light" and a Race Committee Vessel.

Time Limit: Saturday 1630 for all classes. All starters who have not finished will be scored TLE.

Due In writing 3 hours after protesting yacht's finish time. Heard 1800 May 16th at GIYS. **Protests:**
