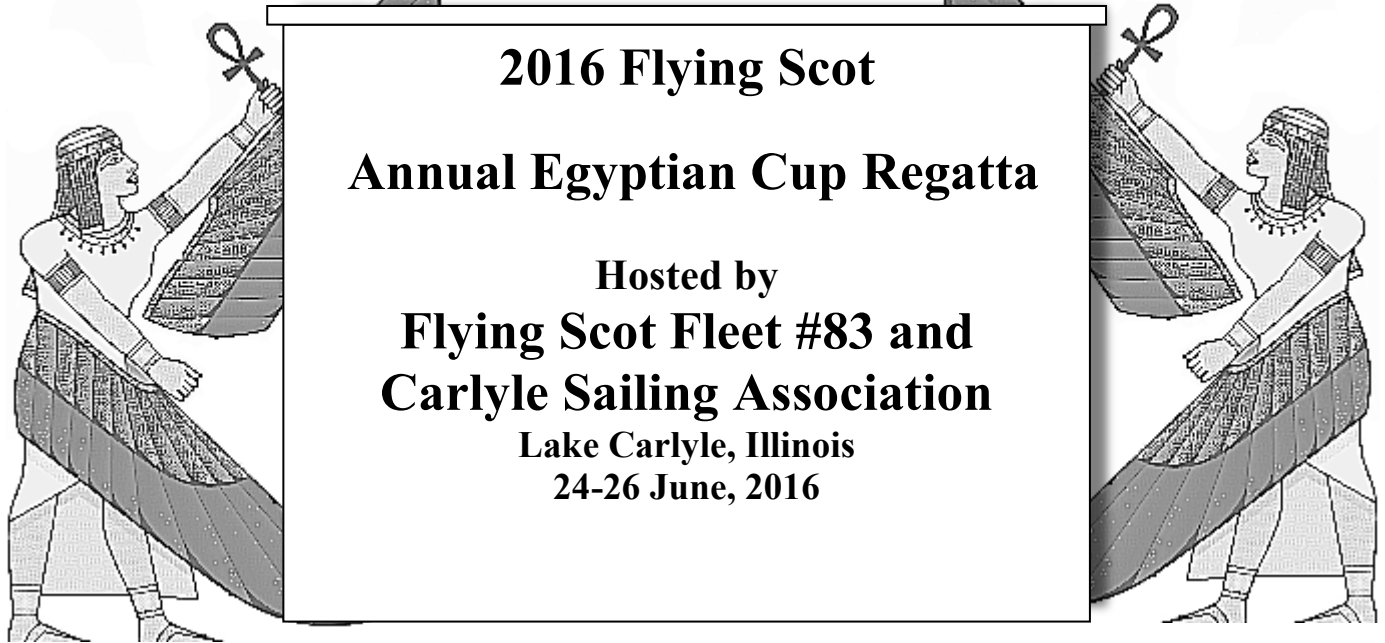


NOTICE OF RACE



2016 Flying Scot Annual Egyptian Cup Regatta

Lake Carlyle, Illinois
24-26 June, 2016

Carlyle Lake is a 26,000-acre, 7 miles long and 3 miles wide, man-made lake. It is located approximately 60 miles east of St. Louis, Mo. The winds in June are moderate with temperatures in the 80s to low 90s. Carlyle Lake provides excellent sailing and accommodations.

Eligibility, Race Rules, Scoring and Awards: The regatta is open to all Flying Scots. The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016* (RRS), the rules of FSSA, including Article S-V (7) (c) (radio communication) and the Race Committee's sailing instructions. Scoring will be a low-point scoring system. No races will be excluded from a boat's series score. Trophies will be awarded to the top five finishers. The Egyptian Cup perpetual trophy (non-traveling) will be awarded to the Egyptian Cup Regatta Champion. A maximum of five races may be sailed, of which one race will constitute a regatta. All boats may be checked for safety equipment as required by the FSSA rules.
