1. **RULES** The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
2. **ADVERTISING** The regatta shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. In addition, no advertising shall be displayed on hulls or sails except a maker's mark of six inch square size or smaller unless the applicable class rules specify otherwise.
3. **APPLICATION** Application shall be made by completing the entry form and returning it to the registration committee.

4. **DONATION** The entry donation for all competitors is
 1. Sailboats with Captain: \$40.00 + \$5.00 each additional crew; \$50.00 + \$5.00 per crew AFTER 5/13/16
 2. Junior Boat with Captain: \$10.00 ; \$20.00 AFTER 5/13/16

Early bird registration period ends at midnight on 5/14/16.

Five races -- One Design and Cabin Around the Buoys; Two races -- Long Distance; As many as possible -- Juniors
6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** The sailing instructions will be available at registration, or check online at http://www.csa-sailing.org/Sailing_for_Vets.html
7. **RACING AREAS** There will be separate racing areas/courses for one design cabins, one designs, juniors and long distance. Courses for One Design, Juniors and Cabin Around the Buoys may be Olympic Modified, Windward-Leeward, or Triangular laps. The Long Distance races will have staggered starts (Pursuit/Hare and Hound).

8. **SCORING**

8.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply for all classes.

One race shall be completed to constitute a series. No race scores shall be discarded. This modifies RRS A.2.

8.2 For divisions using handicaps, the finish positions will be determined:

a. For miscellaneous divisions on the one-design course, the Portsmouth (Beaufort) Yardstick shall be used.

b. For the cabin around the buoys course and the Long Distance Course, the CYC PHRF Handicap Ratings shall be used.

9. **PRIZES** Each fleet will be awarded first, second and third place trophies.
