

# Lake Norman Yacht Club Junior Program 2016 Junior Series Notice of Race

## 1. RULES

1.1 The Junior Series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2013-2016 (*RRS*).

### 2. CLASSES

- 2.1 Classes for the Junior Series are as follows: Optimist Green Fleet; Optimist White Fleet, Optimist Blue Fleet and Optimist Red Fleet; Sunfish (including Sunfish Midget); Laser Full, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7; and Club 420 with spinnakers and trapezes.
- 2.2 Optimist age restrictions are as follows:

Green Fleet<br/>White FleetSailor must be a novice up to age 15 at the time of the last series date.White Fleet<br/>Blue FleetSailor age 10 and under at the time of the last series date.Red FleetSailor age 13, 14, or 15 at the time of the last series date.

- 2.3 The competitor's age on the date of the last race of the series (Oct. 8, 2016) will be used for Optimist fleet placement and scoring.
- 2.4 For each event, two boats will constitute a fleet.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 Sailors 18 years old and younger are eligible to sail in the LNYC Junior Series.
- 3.3 **Registration and waiver forms are required for all sailors.** All competitors must have completed Junior Program registration, filed waiver forms with both sailor and parent signatures, and paid the Junior Program fees.
- 3.4 The registration fee is \$38 for "Junior Members" and \$50 for "non-members". The registration fee is included in the annual dues for "Youth members".

### 4. SCHEDULE

4.1 The Junior Series shall be a series of events, including Junior Series "Race Days" and LNYC invitational "Regattas". The schedule is as follows:

4.2 Junior Series "Race Day" events are sailed on Saturdays. The schedule is as follows:

#### 930 – Competitors meeting and instruction at the Pavilion 1030 – Earliest Warning Signal for first race

- 4.3 There will be no more than five races per day for Junior Series "Race Day" events. One race completed shall constitute an event.
- 4.4 The Sailing Instructions for the Junior Series "Race Day" events will be online at the LNYC website.
- 4.5 LNYC invitational "Regattas" which are part of the Junior Series include the Hospice Regatta, Sail Camp Regatta, Independence Day Regatta, Labor Day Regatta, and Board Bash Regatta.
- 4.6 The Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for each of these invitational "Regattas" will dictate the schedule and number of races to be sailed.

### 5. SCORING

5.1 The Junior Series is scored as a series of "Race Day" and "Regatta" event results. Each sailor's overall series score will be the total of the best **four** event scores.

5.2 Except for Optimist Green Fleet, the Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will be followed, except that no score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

- 5.3 Optimist Green Fleet is scored separately from the other Optimist fleets and will be based on participation only in accordance with USODA guidelines.
- 5.4 Sailors in regattas will only be scored relative to other Junior Series Participants.
- 5.5 420 Skipper and 420 Crew will be scored separately.

- 5.6 Full, Radial and 4.7 Lasers will be scored separately.
- 5.7 Optimist White, Blue and Red Fleets are scored overall and by fleet.
- 5.8 Sunfish and Sunfish Midget fleets are scored together.
- 5.9 The sailor's age on the date of the last race of the series (October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016) will be used for Optimist fleet placement and scoring.
- 5.10 Scores will be posted on the Notice board at the Pavilion and on the Regatta Network link on the LNYC website.

#### 6. AWARDS

- 6.1 Junior Series Awards will be presented at the Junior Program Banquet at the end of the season.
- 6.2 The number of awards to be presented for each fleet is as follows:

- 6.3 The Optimist Championship is awarded to the sailor with the lowest overall point total at the end of the series.
- 6.4 Fleet Awards are presented to the sailors in each fleet with the lowest point totals at the end of the series.
