**1. Organizing Authority & Host**

**2. Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**3. Eligibility & Entry**

**3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist class (including wood, plastic and fiberglass hulls) and Collegiate 420. (ie No spinnaker or trapeze.) They will race and be scored in 3 classes; the Optimist Gold class will consist of Optimist sailors with 1.5 years or more of sailing experience, all other Optimist sailors will sail in the Silver class and a 420 class.

You will see “Kimberly Bergalis Memorial Park” on the left and Jaycee Park will be on the right. Turn right on Malaleuca Dr. and go to the end. Parking is in this area on the right. The boat house is located on the water, north of the parking area.
