

Organizing Authority: Columbus Day Regatta, Inc.

1. <u>Rules:</u>

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. Eligibility:

The regatta is open to boats of the following classes:

PHRF CLASS: Current PHRF certificate. If the certificate is not from Southeast Florida PHRF, it may be subject to adjustment by the Columbus Day Regatta Ratings Committee.

ONE DESIGN: To be determined by Committee. **NOTE:** All Yachts currently racing PHRF or One Design shall be entered in those fleets. Entries submitted without certificates will not be accepted.

ASSIGNED RATING CLASS: Any boat with present or past racing ability, 18' or larger LOA, will have a rating assigned by the Committee and must use the sails declared by the Master on the entry form. Picture and manufacturer specifications must accompany application form. Yachts intending to use two genoas downwind must declare them on the entry form.

MULTIHULL: Permanent cruising accommodations – Catamarans or Trimarans, 24' or larger, using MASF rating.

GUNKHOLE CLASS: Cruising pleasure yachts, as selected by the Committee, will have a rating assigned by the Committee. Picture and manufacturer specifications must accompany application form. Spinnakers, bloopers, or specialized sails will not be allowed. (Specialized sails are any sail flown free and not hanked on).

SALM FREEDOM CLASS: Shake-A-Leg Miami's Freedom 20's open to both disabled and able bodied competitors.

BEACH CATS: Beach Cats, Fast Cats and Spinnaker Cats (16ft or longer) are invited to participate. Classes will be assigned based on sufficient number of entries

3. Entry:

Competitors may register by completing the online entry form found at **www.columbusdayregatta.net** and paying the entry fee. Entries without boat ratings must supply a picture and manufacturer specifications along with a copy of their entry to Columbus Day Regatta, c/o Coral Reef Yacht Club, 2484 S. Bayshore Drive, Miami, Florida 33133; or contact the CDR Chairman at CHRIS LANZA (305) 956-9040. **The DEADLINE for entering shall be Midnight Monday, October 3rd, 2016.** Positively no entries will be accepted after that date.

6. <u>Courses:</u> (will be described in regatta brochure)

**** It is the intention if the Race Committee to start and finish all classes in the vicinity of the entrance to Dinner Key Channel approximately 0.5 nautical miles NE Donovan's. An orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and a Red Bacardi inflatable mark will designate both the start and finish lines.

**** All courses will be posted via course flags on the Race Committee Signal Boat. Please refer to the regatta brochure for description and meaning of course flags.

**** A one way course each day from the start to a finish off of Black Ledge on day 1 and a reciprocal course on day 2 for Gunkhole classes is being considered based upon the number of boats entering these classes.

7. Sailing Instructions:

Final sailing instructions, starting times, course information, Columbus Day flag, class flag, scratch sheet and boat number will be included in the packet to be picked up and signed for by each master or his representative on October 6th and 7th at the following places and at the time indicated (See section 5 above).
