This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR), except as any of these are altered by this Notice, and the Sailing Instructions which will be available before the regatta on www.tayc.com and at Registration.

ELIGIBILITY:

Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26.4

REGISTRATION:

FEES:

Entry fee: \$40

MEASUREMENT:

1. Boats and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.
2. No weigh in required.

RACING AREA:

The racing area will be the vicinity of Choptank Light unless signals are made ashore on the official notice board.

Star class will be sailing on the same course as the Shields fleet.

COURSES:

Courses and procedures will be attempted in accordance with STCR 34. STCR 34.7 Format C shall

apply.

SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

LAUNCHING:

Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers to be stored in designated area clear of the hoist and access lanes.

SOCIAL:

There will be a BBQ after racing Saturday

PRIZES:

Awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place series finishers
Family trophy: Highest placing family boat crew.

HOUSING:
