## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Class rules will apply.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all boats of the J/22, J/30, J/70, J105 and Etchells classes. Any class that does not have a minimum of 6 entries by midnight Thursday, 21 April 2016 will not be eligible for a start and the entry fees will be returned.

### 4 CLASSIFICATION

There will be no sailor classification requirements beyond those stated in applicable class rules.

### 5 FEES AND ENTRY

5.1 Entry and fee of \$55 are due by 1700 Thursday, April 21, 2016. Entry fees paid prior to April 8, 2016 will be discounted to \$45. Entries are payable in full upon entering and are non-refundable.

5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at [www.annapolisyc.com/racing](http://www.annapolisyc.com/racing).

5.3 The fee includes racing and the awards ceremony with complimentary beer at the AYC Sailing Center.

### 6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The event schedule will be:

6.2 As many as four races will be sailed to be further detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

### 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be posted on the event web site two weeks prior to the event.

### 8 VENUE

8.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.

8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

### 9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward drop mark courses.

**10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 10.1 Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.
- 10.2 Penalties after racing: RRS/US Appendix T, Section B (Post-Race Penalties) will apply.

**11 SCORING**

- 11.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 11.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 A boat's series score will be the total of all of her race scores.

**12 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

**13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

**14 PRIZES**

- 14.1 First, Second, and Third place awards will be presented for each class.
- 14.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

**15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**16 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.
