Notice of Race

<u>Rules</u>: This race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the rules of the classes sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race. Double jibs/genoas for non-spinnaker classes and non-spinnaker yachts sailing in spinnaker classes are allowed.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to members of SCYA recognized Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations, and to any One Design Fleet which established a class. YACHTS RACING IN PHRF MUST HAVE A <u>CURRENT</u> PHRF RATING CERTIFICATE. The following classes are invited to participate: PHRF (Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker), Sport Boat, and One Design Fleets. Four or more entries shall establish a class. Changing classes after first day of racing for each series is not allowed. If a rating change occurs, the new rating will be used and the boat will remain in the original class. PHRF AREA C <u>BUOY</u> RATINGS WILL BE USED.

<u>Entries</u>: Entries shall be on the form below and must be accompanied by a check for the amount of the entry fee made payable to Seal Beach Yacht Club. Entries may be mailed to RACE CHAIRMAN, Seal Beach Yacht Club, 255 Marina Drive, Long Beach, CA 90803 or placed in the Race Entry Box at the Seal Beach Yacht Club. You may also enter on Regatta Network: https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?regatta_id=12342 Participants are encouraged to enter early. Classes and PHRF class breaks will be established from entries received by 1800 May 3, 2016. Four entries will establish a class.

Entry Fee: The fee for all five Series will be \$200.00 if submitted by May 2, 2016 or \$250.00 thereafter. Each individual series entry fee will be \$60.00 per series if submitted by: May 2nd for Series I; May 31st for Series II; June 28th for Series III; July 26th for Series IV; and, Aug. 23th for Series V. The entry fee is \$70.00 for entries submitted after these dates. Boats may be entered for a single race for a fee of \$20.00 per race.

Sailing Instructions & Courses: Seal Beach Yacht Club Course Chart Pop Tops 2016.

Starting Order and First Warning: Established classes, starting order, and PHRF class breaks will be posted at the Club by 1800, May 4, 2016. First warning will be 1755 for each race. There will be one race each day. Each series will have 4 races with one throw out per series. As a courtesy, the Race Committee will attempt to notify recalled boats by hailing their sail number over **channel 71**.

<u>Time Limit</u>: All yachts must finish prior to 2030 the day of the race.

Protests: As prescribed in the Sailing Instructions, and the Pop Tops Arbitration Instruction.

<u>Trophies</u>: Trophies will be presented at Seal Beach Yacht Club after completion of the final race in each series. Trophies will be awarded for individual races as well as the Series winner. Each yacht shall be allowed to throw-out one race when calculating series standings. The number of trophies for each class shall be as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions. Trophies will also be awarded for the overall series winner based on the results of Series I through Series V. One overall series winner will receive the Ray Dunne Memorial Pop Tops Trophy. <u>DSQ's based on a protest hearing are not allowed to be used</u> as a throw-out race. Trophies not claimed within 30 days shall remain the property of Seal Beach Yacht Club.
