The Keowee Sailing Club invites you to the 2016 Keowe Cup Regatta. This regatta is opent to all sailboats undr 35 feet in length with a PHRF or Portsmouth rating.

The regatta is governed by the RACING RULES of SAILING (RRS). The low point scoring system RSS appendix will apply. One race will constitute a regatta. Fleets and PHRF ratings will be accepted at the discretion of the organizing committee. Scoring for keelboats will use the PHRF time-on-time method. Open Dinghy fleets will use Portsmouth scoring. Organizing Committee will consider seperate fleets if 3 or more of a single design register.

Activites include 2 days of racing (weather permitting), Friday hors d' ouevres, Sat and Sun breakfast, Sat bag lunch and evening dinner/party, and a light Sun. lunch. Extra meal tickets can be purchased for crew or guests.

Junior registration is available for sailors age 18 and under, and is the same as adults but at a lower cost.

Courses are described in the Sailing Instructions and may include drop marks, islands, club marks, and shore features, depending on fleet. Recreational fleets will sail "distance". PHRF A and B, and Dinghies generally sail "bouy" courses. Sailing Instructions are available at www.keoweesailingclub.com through our online registration. They will also be available suring registration and on the Official Notice Board.
