

# Notice of Race Dillon Open Regatta SAIL CO Jr Tour Lake Dillon, Colorado August 5 – 7, 2016 Dillon Yacht Club – Dillon, Colorado (USA)

- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
  - **1.1.** Racing Rules will be changed in the Sailing Instructions as follows:
    - **1.1.1.** Rule 29.2 is modified by Recalls.
    - **1.1.2.** Rule 33 is modified by Change of Course
    - **1.1.3.** Appendix A4 and A5 are modified by Starts.
    - **1.1.4.** Rule 35, A4 and A5 are modified by Time Limits.
    - **1.1.5.** Rule 61.3 is modified by Protests.
    - **1.1.6.** Rules 62.2 and 66 are modified by Protests.
    - **1.1.7.** Rule A4.2 is modified by Scoring
    - 1.1.8. Appendix A2 is modified by Scoring.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY/FLEETS/CLASSES

2.1 The regatta is open to all Keelboats, Centerboard boats. Junior Sailors participating in the SAIL CO Jr Tour, and Lasers will sail on a separate course. Fleet/Class racing will be available to those Classes registering 5 or more boats. Classes not able to form a fleet will race in their appropriate PHRF or Portsmouth division. PHRF Classes and/or One design Classes may be started together but will be scored separately.

3.1 Online entry forms and fees must be received no later than August 1, 2016. Walk up registration is available at Regatta during posted Registration Check-In hours. # 6. Measurement

- Boats racing in the PHRF Fleet must have a current Sailing Association of Intermountain Lakes (SAIL) PHRF certificate. Boats not holding a valid PHRF certificate shall purchase from SAIL PHRF a certificate with the rating to be used for the event before the end of registration. Annual Certificates, which include membership to SAIL are \$20, or temporary one-regatta certificate is \$5, can be purchased during check-in. For non SAIL PHRF members, ratings will be determined by the OA/PRO. PHRF ratings are available on the SAIL website. Boats may not protest or request redress for their own rating or the rating of other boats.
- 6.2 Boats registered under PHRF rating system will be divided into fleets and each fleet must display the identifying streamer provided in their registration packet. Failure to fly this streamer may result in a protest only from the Race Committee and the penalty will be a 20% scoring penalty for any race in which the violation occurs.
- 6.3 Class rule compliance issues should be addressed prior to racing to allow competitors resolution of the noted problem.

# **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
- 7.2 There will be one set of Sailing Instructions for Keelboats, one set for Lasers and centerboard boats, and one for SAIL CO Junior's.

## 8. VENUE:

Keelboats courses will be sailed in the main portion of Lake Dillon. Lasers and SAIL CO Junior's will sail in Dillon Bay.

# 9. NUMBER OF RACES PLANNED:

- 9.1 Eight (8) races are planned for the keelboats and/or centerboard boats.
- 9.2 More than eight (8) races are planned be sailed for the Laser and SAIL CO Junior's.
- 9.3 Races will be run back to back.

## 10. SCORING:

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the sailing instructions, will be used.
- 10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

# **11. SPECTATOR BOATS:**

For the non-racer that wants to watch the racing on the water there will be a total of three spectator boats that will depart at 11:45 and 1:30 each day for a 90-minute excursion. The boats will accommodate 10 people each and the cost is \$25 per adult or child per ride.

# **12. FACILITIES:**

Dillon and Frisco Bay Marinas have overnight slips, showers and restrooms that are available to all regatta participants and guests. Small boats may launch and utilize the Dillon Beach adjacent to the launch ramp. Please contact the Dillon Marina office at (970) 468-5100 or the Frisco Marina office at 970-668-4334 for slip availability. Trailer storage will be provided by the Town of Dillon and designated at the time of check in by obtaining a trailer permit at no charge from the Dillon Marina office. ALL BOATS MUST COMPLY WITH STATE MANDATED AQUATIC NUISANCE INSPECTION GOING INTO AND COMING OUT OF THE WATER.

#### 13. TROPHIES:

First, second and third places trophies will be awarded to the winning boat in each class with 5 or more boats.

## 14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 14.1 Boats may carry VHF radios onboard.
- 14.2 The RC may attempt to give competitors information concerning starting sequences, schedules and safety information using Channel 68.
- 14.3 Failure to hear any RC transmission shall not be grounds for requesting redress.
- 14.4 Competitors may not transmit radio communication except to declare an emergency.
