NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is Lake Monroe Sailing Association (LMSA), and will be held on Lake Monroe in Sanford, Florida. Regatta headquarters is located at the LMSA clubhouse, 531 N. Palmetto Ave, Sanford, FL 32771.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016.

Divisions:

Competitive Fleet Division for Monohulls (Planing, Sunfish & Displacement boats) and a Fun Fleet Division.

In the **Competitive Division**, a class with six or more boats may be scored separately based on elapsed time. Scoring shall be the Low Point System as defined in Appendix A of the *RRS*. Rule A2 is changed so that no races will be discarded.

Entry and Eligibility:

The **Competitive Divisions** are open to monohull sailboats only with a US Sailing Portsmouth issued rating. These Divisions will race under a normal start sequence. A female skipper is required. Except for Sunfish, you must also have at least one female crew member and may add one male as active crew. Team colors/costumes are encouraged.

The **Fun Fleet Division** is open to monohull and cruising multihull sailboats only with a US Sailing Portsmouth issued rating. This division will not have a standard start sequence. A female skipper is required. You must have a minimum of one additional female crew member (no limit to other females on board). One token male is permitted to serve drinks and snacks but he cannot participate in running the boat, hoisting sails, etc., though verbal instruction is allowed. If deemed necessary said token male may aide in leaving and returning to the dock/slip. Winning is not based on speed or finishing first, but on creative costumes/team attire and strongly encouraged bribes to the judges.

Races: A total of 5 races are planned for the **Competitive Fleet**, completion of 1 race constitutes a regatta. W/L and Triangle courses may be offered. The **"Fun Fleet"** course, consisting of one distance race, will be announced at the competitors' meeting.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and a copy will be posted on the Notice Board.

Courses: The courses will be included in the sailing instructions and posted on the notice board.

Awards: Trophies for all classes will be awarded Saturday evening. The youngest female sailor shall receive the "Littlest Lady on the Lake" trophy. The overall PHRF winner will receive a special award and have her name engraved on the "Ladies On The Lake" Overall Perpetual Trophy.
