NOTICE OF RACE

1. **RULES:** The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the participating classes and the Sailing Instructions will govern all races. Rules of all classes are altered so that class membership is not required. Rule 30.1 Round-an-End Rule is in effect at all times (the “I” flag will not be displayed).
2. **CLASSES:** Optimist White, Blue & Red Fleets, Sunfish Red & Blue Fleets, Laser Radial and Club 420.
3. **AWARDS:** Optimist Red, White & Blue Fleets 1st to 5th, Sunfish Red & Blue Fleets 1st to 5th, Laser Radial 1st to 5th and 420 1st to 5th. Awards to follow racing.
The Junior State Championship Sunfish Trophy is awarded to the top-finishing Sunfish competitor age 8 to 13.
The Junior State Championship Sunfish Trophy is awarded to the top-finishing Sunfish competitor age 14 to 17.
4. **APPLICATIONS:** The entry form will ONLY be available online at www.pbycnj.com

5. **FEE:** Entry Fee: - \$50 single-handed and \$100 double-handed (420 or Sunfish). Late entries will be accepted at the PBYC on the race day up to close of registration. **NO LATE FEE.** Registration fee includes; lunch, commemorative tee-shirt and awards if applicable. Additional lunches for visitors are available for \$5.00 each.
6. **SCHEDULE:** Thursday, June 30, 2016
 - 6.1. 0800-0900 Check In and Late Registration
 - 6.2. 0900-0930 Skippers’ Meeting
 - 6.3. 0945 Harbor Start
 - 6.4. 1015 First Warning Signal all Classes. Races to follow
 - 6.5. Lunch break will be on land. Five (5) Races are scheduled. One race constitutes a Regatta.
7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be available at check-in.
8. **VENUE:** Pine Beach Yacht Club. The racing will be on the Toms River and Barnegat Bay.
9. **COURSES** – Port triangle courses.
10. **SCORING** – The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the RRS. If more than three races are completed, each boat’s worst finish will be excluded from its series score. This changes Rule A2.
11. **OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:**
T-shirts provided for all sailors (guaranteed for registrations received prior to June 20, 2016). Lunch will be an old-fashioned July 4th style BBQ including hamburgers, hotdogs, chips, and drinks. Lunch is included for all registered sailors and one coach per yacht club. Parents, siblings, additional coaches and others can purchase lunch for an extra \$5.00 per lunch.
