RULES

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, Sailing Instructions and notices on the official bulletin board in front hall of clubhouse.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices and changes to Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official bulletin board located in the club house.

SKIPPERS' MEETING

The skippers' meeting will be held in the clubhouse at 0915. (Not Mandatory)

COURSES

The identifying letters will be displayed from the Committee Boat before or with the warning signal. In the case of Course "W", the number of laps to be sailed will be indicated in connection with the course signal.

All Government Marks and aids used to Navigation will be used.. The course can be changed at the discretion of the Race Committee at any mark of the course.

START

Races will be Club starts. The starting line will be between the orange flag on TAYC upper deck and the nearby orange starting mark.

RECALLS

Individual Recalls will be signaled by code flag "X" (White with blue cross) and one horn blast. The committee will attempt to hail the sail number(s) of the premature starter(s). Whether or not the hail is heard, responsibility for starting properly rests with each yacht.

General Recall will be signaled by display of code flag "First Substitute" (yellow and blue pennant) and two guns or horn blasts. Class start order will remain intact and recalled class will re-start.

TIME LIMIT:

All yachts shall finish within three hours of her start. Failure to finish within the time limit shall result in a DNF for that race.

FINISH

The finish line will be between R-2 and the TAYC upper deck.

PROTESTS

A yacht desiring to protest must notify the other contestants involved. The protesting yacht shall notify the race committee boat at the finish line and receive acknowledgment. A written protest must be filed with the Race Committee within one hour after the committee boat returns to the dock. Time and location of protest meetings will be posted on the official bulletin board.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A will apply. One race shall be completed to constitute a series.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the clubhouse after the final race on October 2nd. 1st/3, 2nd/5
