NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 PHRF N competitors may use double headsails.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

CRAB/Freedom 20Harbor 20PHRF SpinnakerAlerion Express 28J/70PHRF NCal 25Cal 25Cal 25

- 2.2 Additional one-design classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Wednesday, 17 August 2016.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$55 for entries received by 2000 hours on Monday, 01 August 2016. The entry fee is \$75 for entries received after 2000 hours on Monday, 01 August 2016, but before 2000 hours on Thursday, 18 August 2016.
 - Entries for boats requesting a courtesy PHRF rating must be received by 2000 hours on Friday, 12 August 2016.
 - Entries for boats with a valid PHRF certification must be received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 18 August 2016.
- 2.4 Because this is a charity event, all proceeds from entry fees will be donated to CRAB. Therefore, refunds will not be granted for cancelled registrations.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Thursday, 04 August 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

5 VENUE

- 5.1 Racing will be on the Severn River and on the adjacent waters of the Chesapeake Bay.
- 5.2 A post-race party at the EYC clubhouse will be held after the conclusion of racing.

6 COURSES

- 6.1 All classes except for the Harbor 20 class will sail one (1) pursuit-style race with a reverse-PHRF starting order using CBYRA Region 3 Annapolis Area standard racing marks. This modifies RRS 26.
- 6.2 The Harbor 20 class will sail one (1) fixed mark course in the Severn River, as described in the Sailing Instructions, started in accordance with RRS 26.

7 PRIZES

- 7.1 Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Places will be awarded for the Overall finish positions in the pursuit race.
- 7.2 Special trophies for 1st and 2nd Places will be awarded in the CRAB/Freedom 20 class.
- 7.3 Prizes in the PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF N, Alerion Express 28, Cal 25, Harbor 20, and J/70 classes will be as follows:

1st and 2nd Places for six (6) or more entries;

- 3^{rd} Place for seven (7) or more entries.
- 7.4 The North Sails Fleet Award will be presented to the One-Design fleet with the greatest number of boats on the start line at the Boatyard Bar & Grill Race to Benefit CRAB.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Boatyard Bar & Grill Race to Benefit CRAB entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

9 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 This is a Clean Race. All competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. RRS 55 prohibits placing trash in the water.
