NOTICE OF RACE

1. MANAGEMENT

1.1. The Lloyd Harbor Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this event.

2. RULES

- **2.1.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in:
 - **2.1.1.** The *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the current PHRF regulations as administered by YRA of Long Island Sound (YRALIS) including non-spinnaker regulations and the current Minimum Equipment and Safety Recommendations of YRALIS, Category C.
 - **2.1.2.** YRA of LIS PHRF weight limitations will not apply for this event, nor will credits or penalties for crew weight be applied to the boat's base ratings.
- 2.2. The following racing rules will be changed; 44.1 (two turns penalty), 61.1(a) (informing protestee), 61.3 (protest time limit) 62.1a (redress for RC hail for OCS), 35, A4, A5 (scoring DNS, DNF). The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1.** The regatta is open to boats of PHRF classes whose owner is a member in good standing of the LHYC. Eligible boats can enter using the Lloyd Harbor Yacht Club's online registration at www.lhyc.org, following the link to the Race Information page. The final deadline for entries is 1700 hrs, August 20, 2016.
- **3.2.** There will be two divisions, Cruising and Racing. Boats which generally do not race and use "cruising canvas" will race in the cruising division. All other boats will race in the Racing Class.
- **3.3.** Entrants must possess a valid YRALIS PHRF certificate, a valid one-design certificate, or receive a waiver and LHYC handicap rating from the LHYC Measurer.
- **3.4.** This is a Non-Spinnaker event. No spinnakers of any variety may be used.

4. FEES

4.1. There is a \$15 fee for this event which goes toward provisions.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- **5.1.** Racing is scheduled for August 21, 2016.
- **5.2.** There will be a raft up at the Club mooring from 1100 hrs. until about 1300 hrs.
- **5.3.** The scheduled time for the first warning signal is 1400 hrs.
- **5.4.** One race is scheduled.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The sailing instructions will be available on the club web site by August 20 at 1800 hrs. Scratch Sheets will be available on the web site no later than 0900 hrs, August 21, 2016.

7. VENUE

7.1. The venue is Huntington Bay. The starting area will be at Nun "2" at the entrance to Lloyd Harbor.

8. COURSES

- **8.1.** The course for all classes will be indicated by the race committee and be comprised of government marks.
- **8.2.** The course will either be out to "11B" and back, or between Nun "2" (Lloyd Harbor), Flasher "1" (Sand City), and Bell "8" (Target Rock), in the direction as indicated by the Race Committee.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. The first two sentences of Rule 44.1 are changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when it may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.".

10. SCORING

10.1. Time allowances will be as per YRALIS PHRF procedures using the Time on Distance method.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 11.1. Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 72.
- **11.2.** Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1. Prizes will be given as follows: Overall winner will receive the Little Brown Jug award.
- **12.2.** Prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third place finishers in both divisions.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

14.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
