NOTICE OF RACE**

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the 2016 SAYRA Junior Championship Series Notice of Race.
1.2 E-Scows will be required to race with Float Paks at the top of the mast.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design boats with 4 or more boats registered.
2.2 This is a Points Regatta for the SAYRA Junior Series for the Optimist, Sunfish, Laser and Club 420 classes.
2.3 Laser class boats may register and sail as Laser Full, Radial or 4.7. A boat must sail the regatta in the rig as registered.

4. SCHEDULE:

5. SOCIAL:

- Continental breakfast under the Boathouse on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Post race party following last race on Saturday.
- Boathouse and club restaurant are open to sailing participants and guests for the weekend (cash accepted).

Appropriate attire required for the Club restaurant.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. VENUE: Racing will be in Charleston harbor.

8. THE COURSES & CLASS FLAGS: The courses will be “around the buoys” and will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Class flags will be posted by 1100 Saturday.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM: US Sailing Appendix T1, T2, T3, T4.2 and T 4.4 are in effect.

10. SCORING:

10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply; except that a boat’s final score shall be the sum of all races, with no throw outs unless 6 or more races are sailed.

This changes Rule A2.

10.1 An unlimited number of races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.

12. AWARDS:

- Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of boats competing in each Class.
- Recipients of the CYC Philip O’Neal Harvey Memorial, Henry Clay Robertson IV and Hopkins trophies will be announced at the awards ceremony.
