9.0 DIRECTIONS TO GIBSON ISLAND

From I-97 Baltimore or Annapolis, take Route 100 EAST, continue after merge on MD-177 (Mountain Road), follow the signs to Gibson Island. At security gate, inform the Gate attendant that you are going to the Junior Regatta, receive a pass, **proceed to the boathouse to complete entry** or "The Point" if you are already entered.
